

- 13 (a) (1) THE BOARD MAY FULFILL THE NOTICE REQUIREMENT UNDER § 14 4–208 OF THIS ARTICLE BY POSTING ONLINE A COMPLETED APPLICATION AT LEAST 15 14 DAYS BEFORE THE HEARING DATE.
- 16 **(2)** In addition to the newspaper notice required under § 4–208 of this article **OR THE ONLINE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, the Board shall post a suitable notice in a conspicuous place on the location described in the application for at least 30 days before the application hearing.
- 20 (b) A notice under this section shall state the class of license for which application 21 is made and the date, time, and location of the application hearing.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
