# 2 Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program in Prince George's County

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program  $\mathbf{5}$ in Prince George's County; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the 6 Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain 7 compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the 8 Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; 9 requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Prince 10 George's County Executive and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; 11 providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to 12Study a Promise Scholarship Program in Prince George's County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That:

(a) There is a Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program in PrinceGeorge's County.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
 1, 2016. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2017, with
 no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no
 further force and effect.
