18 19	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "CLOSED SWIMMING LAKE" MEANS A BODY OF WATER THAT:
20	(1) IS NO MORE THAN 1.5 ACRES IN SURFACE AREA;

- 2 (B) A CLOSED SWIMMING LAKE LOCATED WITHIN AND MAINTAINED BY A
- 3 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AND ONLY ACCESSIBLE TO RESIDENTS OF THE
- 4 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE REGULATIONS THAT APPLY TO
- 5 PUBLIC BATHING BEACHES UNDER COMAR 26.08.09 OR ANY COUNTY
- 6 REGULATIONS RELATED TO PUBLIC SWIMMING FACILITIES.
- 7 (C) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT MAINTAINS A CLOSED SWIMMING
- 8 LAKE SHALL ESTABLISH A POLICY TO ASSESS AND MONITOR THE WATER QUALITY OF
- 9 THE CLOSED SWIMMING LAKE.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
- 11 1, 2016.
