21 22 23	WHEREAS, The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission is required by law to establish certain ethics regulations for its employees with respect to conflicts of interest and financial disclosures; and



- WHEREAS, The Commission has established a Board of Ethics in accordance with Title 5, Subtitle 8, Part IV of the General Provisions Article that is equivalent to the provisions of the State Ethics Law; and
- WHEREAS, The Commission contends that the Board of Ethics is unable to perform its function effectively without similar authority to issue subpoenas as the State Ethics Commission; now, therefore,
