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Prince George's County – Board of License Commissioners – Budget and Funding

5 FOR the purpose of altering procedures for the approval of the annual budget for the Board 6 of License Commissioners of Prince George's County; providing that the budget is 7 not subject to the approval of the County Council or County Executive of Prince 8 George's County if the budget does not exceed the amount of certain estimated 9 revenues; providing for the manner in which certain revenue is estimated; 10 authorizing the Board to include in the budget a certain maximum amount for 11 certain purposes; requiring the County Executive and County Council to establish a 12 certain fund for a certain purpose; prohibiting the use of the fund in a certain 13 manner; requiring the County Executive and County Council to distribute a certain amount to the fund; requiring the Board to use the money in the fund, on or before a 14 15 certain date, for certain purposes; making conforming changes; providing for the 16 termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to the budget and 17 funding for the Board of License Commissioners of Prince George's County.
