- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 18 (A) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION, AN AUTHORITY, TO THE MAXIMUM

- 21 (B) AN AUTHORITY SHALL AVOID DENYING ELIGIBILITY FOR PUBLIC
