BY adding to Article – Agriculture Section 3–1001 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 10. Veterinary Feed Directives" Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture SUBTITLE 10. VETERINARY FEED DIRECTIVES. 3-1001.
