1 AN ACT concerning

2 Food Service Facilities – Automated External Defibrillator Program

- FOR the purpose of requiring the owner and operator of a certain food service facility to develop and implement an automated external defibrillator program that meets certain requirements; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems jointly to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to an automated external defibrillator program for food service facilities.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Health General
- 17 **21–330.3.**
- 18 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY THAT
- 19 **HAS:**
- 20 (1) AN ANNUAL GROSS INCOME OF \$400,000 OR LESS; OR
- 21 (2) A SEATING CAPACITY OF LESS THAN 50.

- 1 (B) THE OWNER AND OPERATOR OF A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13–517 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- 4 (C) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE AND THE 5 MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS JOINTLY 6 SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT:
- 7 (1) ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR PERIODIC INSPECTIONS AND 8 ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS; AND
- 9 (2) ASSIST THE OWNER AND OPERATOR OF A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY 10 IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
