17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE HEALTHY KIDS AWARD 18 PROGRAM.

20(C)THE DEPARTMENT, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF21HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM.

1 (1) REWARD SCHOOLS THAT IMPLEMENT POLICIES AND PRACTICES 2 THAT CREATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS TO BE PHYSICALLY ACTIVE AND 3 MAKE HEALTHY FOOD CHOICES THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL DAY;

4 (2) ENCOURAGE THE INTEGRATION OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY INTO 5 NONPHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES, RECESS, AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES 6 THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL DAY; AND

7 (3) ESTABLISH GUIDELINES THAT A COUNTY BOARD MAY ADOPT TO 8 PROMOTE QUALITY RECESS PRACTICES AND BEHAVIORS THAT ENGAGE ALL 9 STUDENTS AND INCREASE THEIR PHYSICAL ACTIVITY LEVELS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2016.
