BY adding to Article – Insurance Section 27–501(s) Annotated Code of Maryland (2011 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Insurance 27-501.WITH RESPECT TO HOMEOWNER'S INSURANCE, AN INSURER MAY NOT: **(S)**
