19	(a) A person is guilty of reckless driving if he drives a motor vehicle:
20	(1) In wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property; or

- 1 (b) A person is guilty of negligent driving if he drives a motor vehicle in a careless 2 or imprudent manner that endangers any property or the life or person of any individual.
- 3 (C) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION THAT CONTRIBUTES TO AN ACCIDENT 4 THAT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON IS A MUST-APPEAR VIOLATION 5 FOR PURPOSES OF § 26–201 OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE PERSON CHARGED WITH THE 6 VIOLATION:
- 7 (1) MAY NOT COMPLY WITH A NOTICE TO APPEAR BY PREPAYMENT OF 8 A FINE; AND
- 9 (2) SHALL APPEAR IN COURT IN PERSON.
