SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A permit 17 expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the 18 permit is issued.

(b) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH AN ALTERNATIVE EXPIRATION DATE FOR A PERMIT TO COINCIDE WITH THE EXPIRATION OF A LICENSE, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATION, OR COMMISSION FOR:

1 (2) A SECURITY GUARD UNDER TITLE 19 OF THE BUSINESS 2 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR

(3) A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER UNDER § 3–306 OF THIS ARTICLE.

4 (C) A permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time 5 of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of 6 a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2016.
