A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Community Colleges – Vocational Certificates and Associate's Degrees – Tuition Waiver

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Community College Vocational Certificate and $\mathbf{5}$ Associate's Degree Tuition Waiver Program; specifying that participation in the 6 Program is voluntary and shall be determined by certain counties, in consultation 7 with certain community colleges; exempting certain individuals from payment of 8 tuition to attend certain community colleges under certain circumstances; requiring 9 certain individuals to be counted in certain computations under certain 10 circumstances; requiring certain individuals to apply for certain financial aid; 11 providing for the duration of the tuition waiver; requiring certain individuals to pay 12tuition under certain circumstances, notwithstanding certain provisions of law; 13 specifying how financial aid shall be applied for individuals who receive a tuition waiver; requiring certain community colleges to assist with certain applications for 14financial aid under certain circumstances; requiring the Maryland Higher Education 1516 Commission to make certain determinations and create a certain baseline 17appropriation amount; requiring the Governor annually to include a certain 18 appropriation in the State budget for the Program beginning in a certain fiscal year; 19requiring a certain county and the State to reimburse community colleges for certain 20forgone tuition revenue; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the 21 Community College Vocational Certificate and Associate's Degree Tuition Waiver 22Program.

(I) **BE EXEMPT FROM PAYMENT OF TUITION; AND**

2 (II) BE COUNTED IN COMPUTING FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT 3 ENROLLMENT UNDER § 16–305 OF THIS TITLE IF THE INDIVIDUAL ENROLLS IN A 4 CLASS THAT IS ELIGIBLE UNDER § 16–305 OF THIS TITLE FOR STATE SUPPORT AT 5 THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

6 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS 7 SUBSECTION SHALL SUBMIT A TIMELY APPLICATION FOR ANY STATE OR FEDERAL 8 STUDENT FINANCIAL AID, OTHER THAN A STUDENT LOAN, FOR WHICH THE STUDENT 9 MAY QUALIFY.

10 (E) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN 11 INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES A TUITION WAIVER UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(2) OF THIS 12 SECTION SHALL CONTINUE TO RECEIVE THE TUITION WAIVER UNTIL THE 13 INDIVIDUAL IS AWARDED A VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE OR AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE.

14(2) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (D)(2) OF THIS SECTION, AN15INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PAY TUITION IF THE INDIVIDUAL:

16(I)DOES NOT EARN A MINIMUM GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 2.017ON A SCALE OF 4.0; OR

18 (II) EARNS BELOW A "C" GRADE OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN A 19 COURSE AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

20 (F) (1) ANY STUDENT FINANCIAL AID, OTHER THAN A STUDENT LOAN, 21 RECEIVED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES A TUITION WAIVER UNDER 22 SUBSECTION (D)(2) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLIED FIRST TO PAY THE 23 INDIVIDUAL'S TUITION.

(2) THE TUITION WAIVER SHALL APPLY TO THE DIFFERENCE, IF ANY,
BETWEEN THE CHARGE FOR TUITION AND THE FINANCIAL AID AWARD, NOT
INCLUDING A STUDENT LOAN, THAT THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES.

(3) ON REQUEST, THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL ASSIST ANY
 INDIVIDUAL REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR STATE OR FEDERAL
 STUDENT FINANCIAL AID UNDER THIS SECTION.

30 (G) (1) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2016, THE COMMISSION SHALL
31 DETERMINE THE AMOUNT PER STUDENT OF FINANCIAL AID THAT WAS AWARDED IN
32 FISCAL YEARS 2014, 2015, AND 2016 TO STUDENTS WHO ATTENDED COMMUNITY
33 COLLEGES IN THE STATE.

1(2)THE COMMISSION SHALL AVERAGE THE AMOUNTS DETERMINED2UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO CREATE A BASELINE PER STUDENT3STATE APPROPRIATION UNDER THE PROGRAM.

4 (3) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2018 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR 5 THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET 6 FOR THE PROGRAM AN APPROPRIATION IN AN AMOUNT AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE 7 AMOUNT CALCULATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION MULTIPLIED 8 BY THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM.

9 (H) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A COMMUNITY 10 COLLEGE IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FROM A PARTICIPATING COUNTY AND 11 THE STATE FOR THE FORGONE TUITION REVENUE RESULTING FROM TUITION 12 WAIVERS AWARDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

13 (2) THE FORGONE TUITION DESCRIBED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 14 THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE PAID BY THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED UNDER 15 SUBSECTION (G)(3) OF THIS SECTION, WITH THE REMAINDER BORNE 50% BY THE 16 PARTICIPATING COUNTY AND 50% BY THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2016.
