SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

Article – Transportation



That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) A person who knows or has reason to know that a motor vehicle is not covered 2 by the required security may not:
- 3 (1) Drive the vehicle; or
- 4 (2) If [he] **THE PERSON** is an owner of the vehicle, knowingly permit 5 another person to drive it.
- 6 (D) A PERSON WHO KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT A MOTOR
 7 VEHICLE REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE IS NOT COVERED BY A VALID MOTOR
 8 VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICY MAY NOT:
- 9 (1) DRIVE THE MOTOR VEHICLE; OR
- 10 (2) IF THE PERSON IS AN OWNER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE, 11 KNOWINGLY PERMIT ANOTHER PERSON TO DRIVE THE MOTOR VEHICLE.

- 13 **(A)** Whenever evidence of security is required under this subtitle, a person may not willfully and knowingly create, certify, file, or provide false evidence of required security.
- 16 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY PROVIDE FALSE
 17 EVIDENCE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICY FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE
 18 REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
