8 each year to hire a certain attorney; and generally relating to the Board of License

3 (b) (1) The Board may employ:

4 (i) no more than two full-time administrators whose annual
5 salaries shall be fixed by the Board as in a general County classified salary schedule, within
6 pay grade 16;

7 (ii) inspectors, subject to § 11-206 of this subtitle; and

8 (iii) clerical and other assistants as are necessary.

9 (2) The Board shall employ:

10 (i) a full-time secretary whose annual salary shall be fixed by the
11 Board as in a general County classified salary schedule, within pay grade 13; and

12 (ii) an attorney at an annual salary of [~~\$20,000~~] **\$90,000.**

13 (3) **(I) THE BOARD MAY HIRE AN ATTORNEY ON A CONTRACTUAL**
14 **BASIS TO PERFORM WORK THAT THE ATTORNEY EMPLOYED BY THE BOARD IS**
15 **UNABLE TO PERFORM BECAUSE OF A CONFLICT OF INTEREST.**

16 **(II) THE BOARD MAY SPEND NOT MORE THAN \$10,000 EACH**
17 **YEAR TO HIRE A CONTRACTUAL ATTORNEY UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS**
18 **PARAGRAPH.**

19 (4) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the Board may set the
20 compensation of the employees.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2016.
