Transportation to cause the POW/MIA flag to be flown on the grounds of certain
State buildings whenever the flag of the United States is flown; providing for the
application of a certain provision of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally
relating to the display of the POW/MIA flag on the grounds of State buildings.

HAS A FLAGPOLE ATTACHED TO THE BUILDING; AND 2. 4 IS DETERMINED TO BE STRUCTURALLY UNABLE TO WITHSTAND ADDITIONAL FLAGS BEING FLOWN FROM THE FLAGPOLE.  $\mathbf{5}$ THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES AND THE SECRETARY OF 6 **(C)** TRANSPORTATION SHALL CAUSE THE POW/MIA FLAG TO BE FLOWN ON THE 7 8 GROUNDS OF ALL STATE BUILDINGS UNDER THEIR CONTROL WHENEVER THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES IS FLOWN. 9 10 SECTION 2.
