10 Preamble

- WHEREAS, The Chesapeake Bay's Susquehanna Flats was once the winter home of about half of North America's canvasback duck population, whose numbers were so vast in the 19th century, given the shoals' lush beds of wild celery, that market hunters in the 1870s bagged as many as 15,000 each day and shipped them in canvas bags by boxcar to markets from Baltimore to Boston; and
- WHEREAS, It was the seemingly infinite abundance of this premier North American game bird on the Flats and their near annihilation by unregulated harvesting that helped inspire Congress to enact the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918, which empowered the federal government to set seasons and bag limits on the hunting of migratory game birds; and
- WHEREAS, The decline of submerged aquatic vegetation (SAV) in the Chesapeake Bay, where canvasbacks find wild celery, their principal food supply, has also contributed to the sad demise of these magnificent game birds whose numbers today are only a small
- 24 fraction of their historic numbers: and

- WHEREAS, A key goal of Maryland's multibillion dollar commitment to the Chesapeake Bay restoration effort is the return of SAV, a critical prerequisite for growing and sustaining the canvasback population; and
- WHEREAS, For sportsmen and sportswomen alike, a true measure of a healthy
 Chesapeake Bay means the return of its most iconic symbol so that future generations can
 witness in awe what it was like in the 19th century to see canvasbacks, or "cans", darken
 the skies over the Flats; now, therefore,
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 9 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 11 **7–304.1.**
- 12 THE CANVASBACK (AYTHYA VALISINERIA) IS THE STATE DUCK.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
