16 (g) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a 17 person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may 18 not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the 19 "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by

human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, withoutthe specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

3 (2) A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or 4 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours 5 or at a time when a school-approved activity is taking place.

- 6 (3) (i) For archery hunters in Carroll County or Frederick County, the 7 safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a 8 dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 9 (ii) For archery hunters in Harford County or Montgomery County, 10 the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a 11 dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.

(III) FOR ARCHERY HUNTERS IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE
 SAFETY ZONE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION EXTENDS FOR 50
 <u>100</u> YARDS FROM A DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR ANY OTHER
 BUILDING OR CAMP OCCUPIED BY HUMAN BEINGS IF:

161.THE HUNTER IS ON AN ELEVATED STRUCTURE FROM17WHICH THE POINT OF RELEASE OF THE HUNTER IS AT LEAST 10 FEET ABOVE THE18GROUND; OR

192.A HILL OR ANY OTHER BARRIER IS BETWEEN THE20HUNTER AND THE DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR OTHER OCCUPIED21BUILDING OR CAMP.

(4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or
 occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone
 without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

 26 1, 2016.
