- 2 (a) There is a Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays 2010 Trust Fund.
- 3 (b) The purpose of the Fund is to provide financial assistance necessary to advance Maryland's progress in meeting the goals established in the [Chesapeake 2000 5 Agreement] **2014 CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED AGREEMENT** for the restoration of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, including the Patuxent River, and to restore the health of the Atlantic Coastal Bays and their tributaries, by focusing limited financial resources on nonpoint source pollution control projects in all regions of the State.
- 9 (f) (1) The Fund may be used only for the implementation of nonpoint source 10 pollution control projects to [achieve the State's tributary strategy developed in accordance 11 with the Chesapeake 2000 Agreement] COMPLY WITH STATE AND LOCAL WATERSHED 12 IMPLEMENTATION PLANS and to improve the health of the Atlantic Coastal Bays and 13 their tributaries.
