- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to cancel the commercial driver's license of a person who fails to submit to the Administration a certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 certificate of physical examination; authorizing the Administration to issue a 7 noncommercial driver's license of an appropriate class to an individual whose 8 commercial driver's license is canceled, under certain circumstances; authorizing the 9 Administration to immediately reinstate and, subject to certain conditions, issue a 10 noncommercial driver's license of an appropriate class to an individual whose commercial driver's license is canceled as a result of the failure to submit a certain 11 certificate of physical examination, under certain circumstances; and generally 1213 relating to commercial driver's license cancellations and downgrades.
