- 1 facilitate the development of performance objectives that will result in (2) 2 a comprehensive, effective, efficient, and integrated service delivery system for individuals 3 with disabilities: develop an interagency funding approach to maximize efficiencies and 4 5 streamline access to services and support for individuals with disabilities; 6 formulate policies on legislative issues and, under the direction of the **(4)** 7 Governor, communicate the policies to the General Assembly; [and] 8 develop the State Disabilities Plan; AND (5)9 **(6)** REVIEW THE CONTENT AND MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF 10 THE TRAINING OBJECTIVES AND CURRICULUM ADOPTED BY THE POLICE TRAINING 11 COMMISSION FOR A COMMUNITY INCLUSION TRAINING PROGRAM: 12 **(I)** AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 4 YEARS; OR 13 (II)MORE FREQUENTLY IF REQUESTED BY THE POLICE 14 TRAINING COMMISSION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2016.
