## Public Safety – Handgun Permits – Expiration

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of State Police to establish an alternative
  expiration date for a permit to carry, wear, or transport a handgun if the holder of
  the permit has been issued a certain license, registration, certification, or
  commission to coincide with the expiration of a certain holder's handgun
  qualification license; and generally relating to handgun permits.

#### 17 (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A permit 18 expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the 19 permit is issued.

1 (b) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH AN ALTERNATIVE EXPIRATION DATE 2 FOR A PERMIT <del>IF THE HOLDER HAS BEEN ISSUED A LICENSE, REGISTRATION,</del> 3 <del>CERTIFICATION, OR COMMISSION FOR</del> TO COINCIDE WITH THE EXPIRATION DATE OF 4 <u>THE HOLDER'S HANDGUN QUALIFICATION LICENSE, IF THE HOLDER IS LICENSED,</u> 5 <u>REGISTERED, OR COMMISSIONED AS</u>:

6 (1) A PRIVATE DETECTIVE UNDER TITLE 13 OF THE BUSINESS 7 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE;

8 (2) A SECURITY GUARD UNDER TITLE 19 OF THE BUSINESS 9 OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; <u>OR</u>

10 (3) LAW ENFORCEMENT UNDER § 3–209 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

11(4) (3)A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER UNDER § 3–306 OF THIS12ARTICLE.

13 (C) A permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time 14 of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of 15 a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.
