#### SENATE BILL 526

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  $\mathbf{2}$ That Section(s) 6–101(i) through (o), respectively, of Article – Agriculture of the Annotated 3 Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 6–101(j) through (p), respectively. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 4 as follows:  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Article – Agriculture 7 6-101. 8 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated. 9 (d) "Commercial feed" means a material or combination of materials distributed, or intended for distribution, for use as feed, or for mixing in feed for any animal other than 10 man including feed prepared and distributed for consumption by dogs and cats, or any 11 12domesticated animal normally maintained in a cage or tank, including gerbils, hamsters, 13canaries, psittacine birds, mynahs, finches, tropical fish, goldfish, snakes, and turtles, 14except: Unmixed whole seeds and physically altered entire unmixed seeds that 15(1)16are not chemically altered or adulterated; or 17(2)Commodities such as hay, straw, stover, silage, cobs, husks, hulls, and 18 individual chemical compounds or substances when the commodities, compounds, or substances are not intermixed with other materials or adulterated. 19 20(e) "Contract feed" means a commercial feed which is formulated according to an agreement between a distributor and a contract feeder. 2122(g) "Customer-formula feed" means a mixture of commercial feed, each batch of 23which is mixed according to the specific instructions of any distributee. 24"Distribute" means to exchange, offer for sale, sell, or barter, supply, (h) (1) furnish, or provide commercial feed, customer-formula feed, or contract feed to a contract 2526feeder, or otherwise to supply, furnish, or provide commercial feeds as part of a commercial 27enterprise. 28"DISTRIBUTE" (2) DOES NOT INCLUDE THE DONATION OF 29COMMERCIAL FEED, CUSTOMER-FORMULA FEED, OR CONTRACT FEED. "DONATION" MEANS A DELIVERY FROM A SINGLE PRODUCER TO A 30 **(I)** 31 SINGLE OPERATOR WITHOUT A FEE.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 October 1, 2016.
