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## Morgan State University - Student Housing

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Board of Regents of Morgan State University from 4 entering into any contract for student housing that is located in a certain block of 5 Havenwood Road in Baltimore City unless a certain improvement association 6 approves; requiring the Board of Regents to give certain notice to certain committees 7 of the General Assembly under certain circumstances; specifying certain height 8 restrictions for certain student housing; requiring certain supervision of students 9 who live in certain housing; requiring the Morgan State University Police and Public Safety Department to provide certain patrols of certain student housing subject to 10 certain coordination; specifying a certain priority for certain student housing; 11 12 requiring certain student housing to be converted to certain residential dwelling units under certain circumstances; requiring the developer of a certain shopping 13 14 center to fulfill certain goals and employ certain individuals, to the extent 15 practicable; and generally relating to student housing and Morgan State University.
