  the eligibility of an individual based on a misdemeanor conviction or other certain
  offenses under certain circumstances; requiring an authority to develop certain
  guidance regarding eligibility for tenants with a criminal history; and generally
  relating to access to public housing.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION, AN AUTHORITY, TO THE MAXIMUM 19 EXTENT PRACTICABLE, SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS TO PUBLIC HOUSING FOR 20 EX-OFFENDERS.

(B) AN AUTHORITY SHALL AVOID DENYING ELIGIBILITY FOR PUBLIC
HOUSING TO AN INDIVIDUAL BASED ON A MISDEMEANOR CONVICTION, OTHER
MINOR OFFENSE, OR AN OFFENSE THAT OCCURRED MORE THAN 10 YEARS BEFORE

1THE INDIVIDUAL APPLIED FOR PUBLIC HOUSING UNLESS THE SPECIFIC2CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S CONDUCT DEMONSTRATE THAT DENYING3ELIGIBILITY IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE SAFETY OF OTHER TENANTS.

4 (C) AN AUTHORITY SHALL DEVELOP CLEAR, PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE 5 GUIDANCE REGARDING WHAT TYPES OF CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION IT WILL 6 CONSIDER, INCLUDING HOW THIS INFORMATION WILL BE EVALUATED, IN 7 DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR TENANTS.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2016.
