A BILL ENTITLED

Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State

1 AN ACT concerning

FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its

findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating

to the Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2016. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 3 0, 2017, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
