#### Preamble

21 WHEREAS, Five characteristics of sportsmanship are respect, fairness, integrity, 22 responsibility, and perseverance; and

WHEREAS, Respect is treating others the way you want to be treated, tolerating differences, considering the feelings of others, and dealing peacefully with anger, insults, and disagreements; and

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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WHEREAS, Fairness is playing by the rules, being open-minded, listening to others,
 not taking advantage of others, and taking personal responsibility for your mistakes; and

3 WHEREAS, Integrity is playing with honor, being truthful and trustworthy, having 4 the courage to do the right thing, being reliable, building a good reputation, and being loyal 5 to your team and coaches; and

6 WHEREAS, Responsibility is doing what you are supposed to do, using self-control, 7 being self-disciplined, thinking before you act, considering the consequences of your 8 actions, being accountable for your choices, and accepting the rules of the game; and

9 WHEREAS, Perseverance is always trying your best, being persistent, and never 10 giving up; and

11 WHEREAS, The Mid–Atlantic Recreation and Parks Sports Alliance holds its 12 annual Good Sports Awards Ceremony in February in Annapolis; and

WHEREAS, Under the direction of Al "Hondo" Handy, the Ocean City Recreation
 and Parks Department and several other local partners across the State have successfully
 implemented sportsmanship months at the local level; now, therefore,

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 17 That Section(s) 7–502 through 7–506, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the 18 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–503 through 7–507, 19 respectively.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 21 as follows:

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Article – General Provisions

23 **7–502**.

24 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF 25 FEBRUARY AS MARYLAND SPORTSMANSHIP MONTH.

(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
 RESOURCES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH LOCAL RECREATION AND PARKS
 DEPARTMENTS, TO OBSERVE MARYLAND SPORTSMANSHIP MONTH PROPERLY WITH
 APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

30 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2016.

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
