FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "practice of veterinary medicine" to include 4 the practice of any person who dispenses compounded nonsterile or sterile  $\mathbf{5}$ preparations under certain circumstances; providing an exception certain exceptions 6 7 to a certain prohibition on the practice of veterinary medicine and dispensing certain 8 medication that is not in a certain manufacturer's container for a person who sells or dispenses certain medication in a container with a label showing certain information 9 for use by a certain nonfarm animal and for a licensed veterinarian who dispenses 10 certain compounded preparations to be used for a <del>companion</del> certain nonfarm animal 11 12*under certain circumstances*; providing that certain provisions of law do not prohibit a licensed veterinarian from dispensing, in accordance with a certain provision of 13 14this Act, certain compounded preparations provided by a certain pharmacy; 15authorizing a certain pharmacy to provide certain compounded preparations without
