## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# General Assembly Standing Committees – Recorded Votes and Written Testimony

FOR the purpose of codifying certain rules that require a standing committee of the General 4  $\mathbf{5}$ Assembly to deliver to the Department of Legislative Services certain recorded votes 6 before reporting a certain bill or resolution to the floor; requiring a standing 7 committee to deliver certain written testimony to the Department before reporting a 8 certain bill or resolution to the floor; codifying certain rules that require the 9 Department to make available certain recorded votes on the General Assembly Web site within a certain period of time; requiring the Department to make available 1011 certain recorded votes and written testimony to certain members of the General 12Assembly before a certain bill or resolution is reported to the floor; requiring the 13 Department to link certain recorded votes and written testimony to a certain bill or 14 resolution and maintain the recorded votes and written testimony as permanent public records; and generally relating to recorded votes taken by and written 1516testimony submitted to standing committees of the General Assembly.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

1 BEFORE A BILL OR RESOLUTION IS REPORTED TO THE FLOOR BY A STANDING 2 COMMITTEE, THE STANDING COMMITTEE SHALL DELIVER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF 3 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES:

- 4 (1) THE RECORDED COMMITTEE VOTE ON THE BILL OR RESOLUTION; 5 AND
- 6 (2) ANY WRITTEN TESTIMONY RELATED TO THE BILL OR RESOLUTION 7 THAT WAS SUBMITTED TO THE STANDING COMMITTEE.

9 (A) BEFORE A BILL OR RESOLUTION IS REPORTED TO THE FLOOR BY A 10 STANDING COMMITTEE IN EITHER HOUSE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE 11 DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO EACH MEMBER OF THE HOUSE THE 12 RECORDED COMMITTEE VOTE AND WRITTEN TESTIMONY RELATED TO THE BILL OR 13 RESOLUTION THAT IS SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER § 2–1106 OF THIS 14 TITLE.

15 **(B) (1)** WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER A VOTING SESSION IN A STANDING 16 COMMITTEE ON A BILL OR RESOLUTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH ON THE 17 GENERAL ASSEMBLY WEB SITE THE RECORDED COMMITTEE VOTE AND ANY 18 WRITTEN TESTIMONY RELATED TO THE BILL OR RESOLUTION THAT IS SUBMITTED 19 TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER § 2–1106 OF THIS TITLE.

20 (2) FOR ANY RECORDED VOTES OR WRITTEN TESTIMONY PUBLISHED 21 ON THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WEB SITE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF 22 THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

- 23(I)LINK THE RECORDED VOTE AND WRITTEN TESTIMONY TO24THE RELATED BILL OR RESOLUTION; AND
- 25(II)MAINTAIN THE RECORDED VOTE AND WRITTEN TESTIMONY26AS PERMANENT PUBLIC RECORDS.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 October 1, 2016.

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
