A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Comptroller - Distillery Off-Site Permit

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Office of the Comptroller to issue a distillery off-site permit to a holder of a Class 1 manufacturer's license for certain purposes under 4 certain circumstances; establishing certain limitations on the times and locations that permits may be used in a year; establishing certain requirements and a fee for the permit; authorizing the holder of the permit to provide samples of and sell certain liquor under certain circumstances; requiring that the permit holders have present at each event at least one individual who is certified by an approved alcohol awareness program; and generally relating to liquor and distillery off-site permits.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A DISTILLERY OFF-SITE PERMIT IS \$100. (b) (11)
- THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER MAY ISSUE A DISTILLERY 21 **(1) (Z)** 22 OFF-SITE PERMIT TO THE HOLDER OF A CLASS 1 MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE.

- 1 (2) THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY USE THE PERMIT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 12 EVENTS IN ANY GIVEN CALENDAR YEAR.
- 3 (3) AN EVENT FOR WHICH THE PERMIT IS USED MAY NOT EXCEED 3 4 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.
- 5 (4) A PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT USE THE PERMIT MORE THAN ONCE 6 IN A GIVEN POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN A CALENDAR YEAR.
- 7 (5) THE PERMIT MAY BE USED ONLY FOR AN EVENT THAT:
- 8 (I) HAS AS ITS MAJOR PURPOSE AN ACTIVITY OTHER THAN THE
- 9 SALE AND PROMOTION OF LIQUOR AND FOR WHICH THE PARTICIPATION OF THE
- 10 HOLDER IS A SUBORDINATE ACTIVITY;
- 11 (II) IS ORGANIZED AND CONDUCTED BY A NONPROFIT
- 12 ORGANIZATION OR GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY;
- 13 (III) THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER APPROVES; AND
- 14 (IV) IS HELD ON A NONLICENSED PREMISES OR A PREMISES ON
- 15 WHICH A PERSON MAY OBTAIN A TEMPORARY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- 16 (6) THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO:
- 17 (I) PROVIDE SAMPLES NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF FLUID
- 18 OUNCE PER BRAND OF PRODUCT PRODUCED BY THE PERMIT HOLDER TO
- 19 CONSUMERS;
- 20 (II) SELL NOT MORE THAN THREE 750-MILLILITER BOTTLES OF
- 21 LIQUOR TO A CONSUMER AT ANY GIVEN EVENT OR FESTIVAL FOR OFF-PREMISES
- 22 CONSUMPTION; AND
- 23 (III) SELL BY THE GLASS LIQUOR THE LICENSE HOLDER
- 24 PRODUCES TO PERSONS PARTICIPATING IN AN EVENT AND FOR ON-PREMISES
- 25 CONSUMPTION.
- 26 (7) The permit holder shall have present at an event at
- 27 LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CERTIFIED BY AN APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS
- 28 PROGRAM.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 30 1, 2016.
