A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Retail Business Owners – Automated Teller Machines – Notice of Skimming**
3 **Device**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the owner of a retail business with an automated teller
5 machine located on the premises of the business who has knowledge of an illegal
6 skimming device installed on or near the automated teller machine to post a certain
7 notice in a certain manner and to keep the notice posted for a certain period of time;
8 and generally relating to automated teller machines located on retail business
9 premises.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Business Regulation**

18 **19–104.**

19 **IF THE OWNER OF A RETAIL BUSINESS WITH AN AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE**
20 **LOCATED ON THE PREMISES OF THE BUSINESS HAS KNOWLEDGE THAT THE**
21 **AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE HAS AN ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE INSTALLED ON**
22 **OR NEAR IT, THE RETAIL BUSINESS OWNER SHALL:**

23 **(1) POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE ON OR NEAR THE AUTOMATED**
24 **TELLER MACHINE A NOTICE THAT WARNS CUSTOMERS OF THE AUTOMATED TELLER**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 MACHINE THAT IT HAS AN ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE INSTALLED ON OR NEAR IT;
2 AND

3 **(2) KEEP THE NOTICE POSTED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SECTION**
4 **UNTIL THE ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE IS REMOVED FROM THE AUTOMATED TELLER**
5 **MACHINE BY THE APPROPRIATE ENTITY.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2016.
