18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 (a) A holder of a Class A beer and wine license may sell or provide beer and wine
5 on Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.

6 (b) (1) A holder of a 6-day or 7-day Class B beer and wine license may sell or
7 provide beer and wine for on-premises consumption[:

8 (i) on Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following
9 day[; and

10 (ii) on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day].

11 (2) A holder of a 7-day Class B beer and wine license may sell beer and
12 wine for **ON- OR** off-premises consumption[:

13 (i) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.
14 the following day[; and

15 (ii) on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.].

16 (c) A holder of a Class C beer and wine license may sell or provide beer and wine
17 on Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day.

18 (d) (1) A holder of a 6-day or 7-day Class D beer and wine license may sell or
19 provide beer and wine on Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to midnight.

20 (2) A holder of a 7-day Class D beer and wine license may sell or provide
21 beer and wine on Sunday from [11 a.m.] **8 A.M.** to 11 p.m.

23 (a) A holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license may sell or provide beer,
24 wine, and liquor on Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.

25 (b) A holder of a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license may sell or provide beer,
26 wine, and liquor[:

27 (1) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. the
28 following day[; and

29 (2) on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day].

1 (c) A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell or provide beer,
2 wine, and liquor[:

3 (1) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. the
4 following day[; and

5 (2) on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day].

6 (d) Reserved.

7 (e) A holder of a Class H beer, wine, and liquor license may sell or provide beer,
8 wine, and liquor[:

9 (1) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY** from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. the
10 following day[; and

11 (2) on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. the following day].

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
13 1, 2016.
