1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Hotel Lobby License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Frederick County a hotel lobby license; authorizing the
4 Board of License Commissioners to issue the license for use by a certain hotel;
5 establishing that the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine by
6 the bottle to patrons of the hotel for on–premises consumption; providing for the
7 hours of sale; specifying an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic
8 beverages in Frederick County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

18 **20–1007.1.**

19 **(A) THERE IS A HOTEL LOBBY LICENSE.**

1 **(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A HOTEL THAT DOES**
2 **NOT HAVE A RESTAURANT.**

3 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER AND**
4 **WINE BY THE BOTTLE FROM A STORE IN THE HOTEL LOBBY TO PATRONS OF THE**
5 **HOTEL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.**

6 **(D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER AND WINE:**

7 **(1) ON MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, FROM 6 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE**
8 **FOLLOWING DAY; AND**

9 **(2) ON SUNDAY, FROM 11 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

10 **(E) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$100.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
12 1, 2016.
