2 (a) There is a Class C [(Maryland Ensemble Theatre)] (THEATER) beer and wine 3 license.

4 (b) (1) The president and two other officers of the [Maryland Ensemble 5 Theatre] **THEATER** shall sign the application for the license.

6

Two of the signers shall be residents of the County.

7 (c) The Board may issue a license for use by [the Maryland Ensemble Theatre] A
8 THEATER WITH SEATING FOR 200 OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS PER PERFORMANCE.

9 (d) [The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine for 10 on-premises consumption.

11 (e)] The license [holder may] AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO sell beer 12 and wine for on-premises consumption from 1 hour before to 1 hour after:

13 (1) a regular performance; or

(2)

14 (2) a fund-raiser performance that benefits the [Maryland Ensemble 15 Theatre] **THEATER**.

16 [(f)] (E) The annual license fee is \$100.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 18 1, 2016.
