Public Institutions of Higher Education – General Education Programs – Semester Hour Maximums

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain public institutions of higher education will 5 satisfy a certain general education program requirement by requiring a certain 6 baccalaureate program to include a certain amount of semester hours of required 7 core courses; authorizing certain public institutions of higher education to include a 8 certain course in excess of a certain maximum semester hours amount; requiring the 9 Maryland Higher Education Commission to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the maximum semester hour limit for general education courses at public 10 11 institutions of higher education.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article – Education

- 21 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PUBLIC
- 22 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL SATISFY THE GENERAL EDUCATION
- 23 PROGRAM REQUIREMENT BY REQUIRING EACH BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM TO
- 24 INCLUDE NOT LESS THAN 40 SEMESTER HOURS AND NOT MORE THAN 46 SEMESTER
- 25 HOURS OF REQUIRED CORE COURSES.

- 1 (B) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY REQUIRE A
 2 BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM TO INCLUDE ONE ADDITIONAL 3 SEMESTER HOUR
 3 COURSE ABOVE THE MAXIMUM SEMESTER HOURS FOR A GENERAL EDUCATION
 4 PROGRAM ESTABLISHED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IF THE ADDITIONAL
 5 COURSE IS IN SOCIAL JUSTICE OR CULTURAL COMPETENCY.
- 6 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 7 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2016.
