13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18	(A) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
19	(2) (I) "HUMAN REMAINS" MEANS:
20	1. THE BODY OF A DECEASED PERSON; OR
21 22	2. A PART OF A BODY OR LIMB THAT HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM A LIVING PERSON.



- 1 (II) "HUMAN REMAINS" INCLUDES A BODY OR PART OF A BODY 2 OR LIMB IN ANY STATE OF DECOMPOSITION.
- 3 (3) "VALUABLE CONSIDERATION" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE 4 REASONABLE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REMOVAL, STORAGE, AND 5 TRANSPORTATION OF HUMAN REMAINS.
- 6 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON 7 MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OFFER TO PURCHASE OR SELL, PURCHASE OR SELL, OR 8 OTHERWISE TRANSFER HUMAN REMAINS FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION.
- 9 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
  10 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR A
  11 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.
- 12 (D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE OBTAINING, USING, OR
  13 DISPOSING OF HUMAN REMAINS FOR THE PURPOSE OF TEACHING OR OTHER
  14 APPROPRIATE RESEARCH BY A GOVERNMENT AGENCY OR MEDICAL SCHOOL,
  15 DENTAL SCHOOL, SCHOOL OF NURSING, OR OTHER UNIVERSITY RESEARCH OR
  16 TEACHING UNIT THAT IS PART OF A REGULARLY ESTABLISHED OR CHARTERED
  17 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING IN THE STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
