1 AN ACT concerning

2 Natural Resources – Recreational License Donation Program – Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to purchase and donate certain recreational 4 hunting or fishing licenses and any corresponding stamps for certain purposes; $\mathbf{5}$ authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to issue a donated license or stamp 6 only for use by a Gold Star recipient, a disabled veteran, a disabled member of the 7 armed services, or a permanently disabled person who requires the use of a 8 wheelchair; requiring a recipient of a donated license or stamp to have certain 9 sponsorship; requiring a recipient of a donated hunting license to meet certain 10 hunting safety requirements; limiting to a certain amount the number of eligible 11 persons that may hunt under the authority of a donated license or stamp during one 12recreational license year; prohibiting the Department from charging a fee for the 13issuance of a donated license or stamp; authorizing the Department to issue a 14donated license or stamp to an eligible resident or nonresident of the State; requiring 15the Department to post under certain circumstances certain information on its Web 16 site on or before a certain date each year; requiring the Department to adopt certain 17regulations; requiring the Department to implement the recreational license 18 donation program at or before a certain time; establishing that certain funds are 19 nonlapsing and not subject to reversion to the General Fund the Recreational 20License Donation Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to administer the Fund; 2122requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for 23the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the 24Fund may be used; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
9 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

11 **1–405.**

(A) <u>IN THIS SECTION, "GOLD STAR RECIPIENT" MEANS A RECIPIENT OF THE</u>
 <u>U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE GOLD STAR FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES, PARENTS,</u>
 <u>AND NEXT OF KIN OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN</u>
 <u>COMBAT.</u>

16 (B) A PERSON MAY PURCHASE AND DONATE AN ANGLER'S LICENSE, A 17 CHESAPEAKE BAY AND COASTAL SPORT FISHING LICENSE, OR A HUNTING LICENSE 18 AND ANY CORRESPONDING STAMPS FOR ISSUANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS 19 SECTION.

20 (B) (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A DONATED LICENSE OR 21 STAMP ONLY FOR USE BY <u>A GOLD STAR RECIPIENT</u>, A DISABLED VETERAN, A 22 DISABLED MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES, OR A PERMANENTLY DISABLED PERSON 23 WHO REQUIRES THE USE OF A WHEELCHAIR.

24(2)A RECIPIENT OF A DONATED LICENSE OR STAMP SHALL BE25SPONSORED BY A NONPROFIT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES26RECREATIONAL HUNTING OR FISHING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GOLD STAR27<u>RECIPIENTS</u>, DISABLED VETERANS, DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES, OR28PERMANENTLY DISABLED PERSONS WHO REQUIRE THE USE OF A WHEELCHAIR.

29 (3) A RECIPIENT OF A DONATED HUNTING LICENSE IS SUBJECT TO 30 THE HUNTING SAFETY REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 10–301.1 OF THIS ARTICLE.

31(C) (D)ONLY ONE ELIGIBLE PERSON MAY HUNT UNDER THE AUTHORITY32OF A DONATED LICENSE OR STAMP DURING ONE RECREATIONAL LICENSE YEAR.

33 **(D) (E) THE DEPARTMENT:**

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1 (1) MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DONATED 2 LICENSE OR STAMP; AND

3 (2) MAY ISSUE A DONATED LICENSE OR STAMP TO AN ELIGIBLE 4 RESIDENT OR NONRESIDENT OF THE STATE.

5 (F) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2017, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, 6 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST ON ITS WEB SITE THE NAMES OF THE PERSONS WHO 7 DONATED RECREATIONAL LICENSES OR STAMPS IN THE PREVIOUS RECREATIONAL 8 LICENSE YEARS, UNLESS A PERSON WHO DONATES A LICENSE OR STAMP REQUESTS 9 ANONYMITY.

10 (F) (G) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 11 THIS SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY 12 REQUIREMENTS FOR DONORS, SPONSORS, AND RECIPIENTS OF DONATED 13 RECREATIONAL LICENSES AND STAMPS.

14(G) (H)FUNDS COLLECTED FOR LICENSE DONATIONS UNDER THIS15SECTION ARE NONLAPSING AND MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE16FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

17(1)IN THIS SUBSECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE RECREATIONAL18LICENSE DONATION FUND.

19 (2) <u>THERE IS A RECREATIONAL LICENSE DONATION FUND.</u>

20 (3) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE RECREATIONAL 21 HUNTING AND FISHING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GOLD STAR RECIPIENTS, DISABLED 22 VETERANS, DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES, AND PERMANENTLY 23 DISABLED PERSONS WHO REQUIRE THE USE OF A WHEELCHAIR.

- 24 (4) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 25(5)(1)THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT26SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

27(II)THESTATETREASURERSHALLHOLDTHEFUND28SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

29 (6) <u>THE FUND CONSISTS OF:</u>

30(I)REVENUE COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE31PURCHASE AND DONATION OF RECREATIONAL HUNTING OR FISHING LICENSES OR32STAMPS UNDER THIS SECTION;

1 2	(II) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND; AND
$\frac{3}{4}$	(III) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
5	(7) The Fund may be used only for donated recreational
6	HUNTING OR FISHING LICENSES OR STAMPS FOR USE BY GOLD STAR RECIPIENTS,
7	DISABLED VETERANS, DISABLED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES, OR
8	PERMANENTLY DISABLED PERSONS WHO REQUIRE THE USE OF A WHEELCHAIR.
9 10	(8) (1) <u>The State Treasurer shall invest the money of the</u> <u>Fund in the same manner as other State money may be invested.</u>
11	(II) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE
11 12	CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
13	(9) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN
14	ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
15	(10) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR DONATED

21 22 23 24	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Natural Resources shall implement the recreational license donation program established under this Act at or before the beginning of hunting license sales for the 2017–2018 hunting license year.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2016.

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
