1 (3) A messenger service driver for a messenger service business whose 2 work is not covered employment under paragraph (2) of this subsection may deliver to the 3 public or commercial establishments on foot, by bicycle, or by motor vehicle:

4 (i) individually addressed mail, messages, and documents in paper 5 or magnetic format; and

6 (ii) emergency medical supplies, records, parcels, or similar items if 7 the messenger service business provides to the Secretary evidence of a worker status 8 determination from the Internal Revenue Service or other evidence that the messenger 9 service driver is excluded from coverage under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 11 1, 2016.
