14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 19	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
20 21 22	(2) "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT" MEANS A DEPARTMENT, AN AGENCY, AN OFFICE, OR ANY OTHER BODY OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT THAT IS ESTABLISHED BY LAW.



- 1 (3) (I) "PUBLIC OFFICIAL" MEANS THE HEAD OF A 2 GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- 3 (II) "PUBLIC OFFICIAL" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN OFFICIAL 4 ELECTED BY THE VOTERS UNDER THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.
- 5 (4) "REGULATORY AUTHORITY" INCLUDES THE AUTHORITY TO 6 LICENSE, CERTIFY, OR IMPOSE STATUTORY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL PENALTIES.
- 7 (5) "SOLICIT" INCLUDES THE AUTHORIZED USE OF THE NAME OR 8 IMAGE OF A PUBLIC OFFICIAL IN CAMPAIGN MATERIAL.
- 9 (B) A PUBLIC OFFICIAL MAY NOT SOLICIT, TRANSMIT, OR DEPOSIT IN A
  10 CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT CONTRIBUTIONS OR DONATIONS FOR THE BENEFIT OF A
  11 CANDIDATE FROM A PERSON SUBJECT TO THE REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE
  12 PUBLIC OFFICIAL'S GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
