A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - Wildlife Trafficking Prevention

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from purchasing, selling, offering for sale, or 4 possessing with the intent to sell certain parts or products of certain animal species 5 under certain circumstances, subject to certain exceptions; establishing, under 6 certain circumstances, a rebuttable presumption that a person possesses certain 7 parts or products of certain animal species with the intent to sell; establishing 8 certain penalties for a violation of this Act; authorizing a court to order that a person 9 who violates this Act pay certain restitution; requiring that fines and restitution 10 imposed under this Act be credited and used for certain purposes, subject to a certain 11 exception; establishing a certain additional source of revenue for the Birdwatcher's 12 Fund; authorizing a judge to award a reward to a person providing information 13 leading to a conviction for a violation of this Act; requiring that the reward be paid 14 from a percentage of certain fine proceeds but not exceed a certain amount; 15 prohibiting a reward from being awarded to a law enforcement officer or an employee 16 of the Department of Natural Resources; providing for the disposal of certain seized 17 parts or products of certain animal species; providing for the calculation of the value 18 of certain parts or products of certain animal species for certain purposes; 19 authorizing the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and 20 generally relating to the prevention of wildlife trafficking in the parts or products of 21 certain animal species in the State.
