- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

1 and credit of St. Mary's County, in such amounts as it may deem to be necessary to carry on its work, but at no time shall the total issue of bonds for all purposes under this chapter 2 3 exceed twenty-five (25) percent of the total value of the property assessed for County 4 taxation purposes within all of the sanitary districts in which public water or sewer 5 facilities are located. Subject to the conditions contained herein, the form, tenor, manner of 6 selling and all other matters relating to the issuance of bonds under this chapter shall be 7 prescribed in a resolution to be adopted by the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission 8 prior to sale of the bonds. The issuance of such bonds may not be subject to any limitations 9 or conditions contained in any other law, and the Commission may sell such bonds in such manner, either at public or private sale, and for such price, as it may determine to be for 10 11 the best interests of the Commission and the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County. The bonds shall be serial bonds issued upon the serial maturing plan and in such 12 13 denominations as shall be determined by the Commission. The bonds may be redeemable 14 before maturity at the option of the Commission at such price and under such terms and 15 conditions as may be fixed by the Commission prior to the issuance of the bonds, shall bear 16 interest at such rate or rates payable semiannually, as shall be determined by a resolution 17 of the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission adopted prior to the delivery of the bonds, and shall mature in not more than [thirty (30)] FORTY (40) years after date of issue 18 19 and shall be forever exempt from State, City and County taxation as hereinafter provided. 20 They shall be issued under the signature and seal of the Commission and shall be unconditionally guaranteed as to payment of both principal and interest by the County 2122 Commissioners of St. Mary's County, a political subdivision of the State of Maryland, which 23 guaranty shall be endorsed on each of the bonds in the following language: "The payment 24of interest when due and the principal at maturity is guaranteed by the County 25 Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland." Such endorsement shall be signed on each 26of the bonds by the President and by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of 27 the County, or another person lawfully assigned to the functions of the Clerk, within ten 28 (10) days after the bonds are presented by the Commission to them for endorsement.

B. The principal amount of bonds issued hereunder, the interest payable thereon, their transfer and any income derived therefrom, including any profit made in the sale or transfer thereof, shall be and remain exempt from taxation by the State of Maryland and by the several counties and municipal corporations of this State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
