State Board of Physicians – Authority to Adopt Regulations – Physician Licensing Reciprocity

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Physicians to adopt regulations that 4 would allow the Board to license an applicant who is licensed as a physician in 5 6 another state if the applicant meets certain qualification and licensing requirements 7 and the state in which the applicant is licensed offers a certain reciprocal licensing 8 process; and generally relating to physician licensing reciprocity under the State 9 Board of Physicians requiring the State Board of Physicians to license certain 10 applicants to practice medicine under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to reciprocal licensure for 11 12 physicians.
