3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to develop and adopt 4 certain infrastructure standards on or before a certain date; requiring certain local 5 school systems to meet certain infrastructure standards and implement and consider 6 certain policies related to certain digital devices for certain purposes on or before a 7 certain date; establishing the Digital Equity for All Grant Program and providing for 8 the purpose and duration of the Program; requiring the Department to administer 9 the Program; authorizing the Department to establish certain policies, procedures, 10 and regulations to implement the Program; requiring that certain funds for the 11 Program be provided in the State budget in certain years; requiring the Department 12 to submit certain reports on or before certain dates; defining certain terms; and 13 generally relating to the Digital Equity for All Act.
