4	(a) There is a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license.
5 6	(b) (1) A license under this section authorizes the license holder to sell beer wine, and liquor at retail at the place described in the license.
7 8	(2) The license holder shall sell the beer, wine, or liquor in a sealed package or container that may not be opened or its contents consumed on the licensed premises.
9 10	(c) A license under this section may not be issued for a drugstore unless the applicant:
11 12	(1) has been doing business at the location applied for in the license for a least 1 year before the date of the application for the license;
13 14	(2) is the assignee of a business established for at least 1 year before the date of the application for the license at the location applied for; or
15	(3) has been engaged in the retail drug business for at least 3 years.
16	(d) (1) The annual license fee is <b>[</b> \$300 <b>] \$600</b> .
17	(2) The fee for a Sunday permit is \$250.
