A BILL ENTITLED

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Mental Health – Voluntary and Involuntary Admissions – Certification by Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners

4 FOR the purpose of defining "psychiatric nurse practitioner" for purposes of certain 5 provisions of law relating to the voluntary and involuntary admissions of individuals 6 to certain facilities for the treatment of mental disorders; prohibiting a certificate 7 signed by a psychiatric nurse practitioner for the involuntary admission of an 8 individual to certain facilities for the treatment of a mental disorder from being used 9 for an admission under certain circumstances; requiring a facility operated by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to receive and evaluate an individual, 10 11 within a certain number of hours of notification by a psychiatric nurse practitioner, 12 for an involuntary admission for the treatment of a mental disorder under certain 13 circumstances; making a conforming change; and generally relating to the standards 14 for voluntary and involuntary admissions to facilities for the treatment of mental 15 disorders.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Health General
- 24 10–601.
- 25 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- 1 "Clinical social worker" means an individual who is licensed under Title 19 of 2 the Health Occupations Article to practice clinical social work. 3 "Licensed clinical marriage and family therapist" means an individual who is licensed under Title 17, Subtitle 3A of the Health Occupations Article to practice clinical 4 5 marriage and family therapy. 6 "Licensed clinical professional counselor" means an individual who is licensed 7 under Title 17, Subtitle 3A of the Health Occupations Article to practice clinical 8 professional counseling. "Physician" means an individual who is licensed under Title 14 of the Health 9 (e) Occupations Article to practice medicine in this State. 10 "PSYCHIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS: 11 **(F)** 12 **(1)** LICENSED AS A REGISTERED NURSE AND CERTIFIED AS A NURSE 13 PRACTITIONER UNDER TITLE 8 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE; AND PRACTICING IN THE STATE AS A CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE 14 **(2)** PRACTITIONER-PSYCHIATRIC MENTAL HEALTH. 15 16 "Psychologist" means an individual who is licensed under Title 18 of the [(f)] (G) 17 Health Occupations Article to practice psychology. 10-616.18 19 (a) (1) A certificate for involuntary admission of an individual under Part III of this subtitle shall: 20 21 Be based on the personal examination of the physician, (i) psychologist, or psychiatric nurse practitioner who signs the certificate; and 2223 (ii) Be in the form that the Secretary adopts, by rule or regulation. The rules and regulations shall require the form to include: 24(2)25(i) A diagnosis of a mental disorder of the individual; 26 (ii) An opinion that the individual needs inpatient care or treatment; 27and
- 28 (iii) An opinion that admission to a facility or Veterans' 29 Administration hospital is needed for the protection of the individual or another.

- 1 (b) A certificate may not be used for admission if the examination on which the certificate is made was done:
- 3 (1) More than 1 week before the certificate is signed; or
- 4 (2) More than 30 days before the facility or the Veterans' Administration 5 hospital receives the application for admission.
- 6 (c) A certificate may not be used for an admission if the physician [or], 7 psychologist, OR PSYCHIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER who signed the certificate:
- 8 (1) Has a financial interest, through ownership or compensation, in a 9 proprietary facility and admission to that proprietary facility is sought for the individual 10 whose status is being certified; or
- 11 (2) Is related, by blood or marriage, to the individual or to the applicant.

- Within 12 hours of notification by a physician [or], licensed psychologist, OR
 PSYCHIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER who has certified an individual under Part III of
 this subtitle, a facility operated by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall
 receive and evaluate the individual certified for involuntary admission if:
- 17 (1) The individual's involuntary admission is not limited by § 10–617 of 18 this subtitle;
- 19 (2) An application for admission has been completed;
- 20 (3) A certifying physician [or], psychologist, OR PSYCHIATRIC NURSE 21 PRACTITIONER is unable to place the individual in a facility not operated by the 22 Department; and
- 23 (4) The Department is unable to provide for the placement of the person other than in a facility operated by the Department.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
