## Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Youth and Civic Center License

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Wicomico County a Class B Youth and Civic Center 4 license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to a 5 designee of the County Executive of Wicomico County for use by a certain youth and 6 civic center; during the term of the license, requiring a certain youth and civic center 7 to maintain a kitchen, dining space, and meeting space; authorizing a holder of the 8 license to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption to individuals 9 attending a youth and civic center event; specifying the hours that the license 10 privilege may be exercised; authorizing the license holder to authorize a vendor to 11 sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption under a certain license; 12 authorizing the license holder to contract to receive a proportion of the revenue 13 derived from a vendor's sale of alcoholic beverages; specifying an annual license fee; 14 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Wicomico County.
