## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Seed Community Development Anchor Institution Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Seed Community Development Anchor Institution 4 Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the 5 Department of Housing and Community Development to administer the Fund; 6 requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for 7 the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the 8 Fund may be used; specifying certain eligibility criteria and a certain process for 9 awarding grants and loans from the Fund; providing for the investment of money in 10 and expenditures from the Fund; requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be 11 credited to the Fund; beginning in a certain fiscal year, requiring the Governor to 12 include in the annual budget bill an appropriation of a certain amount to the Fund 13 for certain fiscal years; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring 14 interest on State money in special funds to accrue to the General Fund of the State; 15 defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Seed Community Development 16 Anchor Institution Fund in the Department of Housing and Community 17 Development.

- 7 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS AND LOANS TO
- 8 ANCHOR INSTITUTIONS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN BLIGHTED
- 9 AREAS OF THE STATE.
- 10 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 11 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT
- 12 SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 13 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,
- 14 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 15 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 16 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 17 (2) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
- 18 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR
- 19 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 20 (G) (1) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO PROVIDE GRANTS AND LOANS
- 21 TO ANCHOR INSTITUTIONS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN
- 22 BLIGHTED AREAS OF THE STATE.
- 23 (2) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT OR LOAN, AN ANCHOR INSTITUTION
- 24 SHALL PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF MATCHING FUNDS FROM A PRIVATE SOURCE.
- 25 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL AWARD GRANTS AND LOANS FROM THE
- 26 FUND ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS.
- 27 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
- 28 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
