House Bill 1630 (Delegate Adams)(By Request - Dorchester County Board of Education) and Delegate Mautz

Rules and Executive Nominations

Dorchester County Board of Education - Nonprofessional Personnel
Appointment - Advice and Consent

This bill requires the Dorchester County Superintendent of Schools to attain the advice and consent of the county board of education when appointing clerical and other nonprofessional personnel.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2016.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Dorchester County public school operations and finances are not significantly impacted.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Except in Worcester County and Baltimore City, the county superintendent of schools has sole authority to appoint clerical and other nonprofessional personnel. In Worcester County, the superintendent of schools appoints clerical and other nonprofessional personnel with the advice and consent of the county board of education. In Baltimore City, the appointment, tenure, and compensation of clerical and other nonprofessional personnel is determined in accordance with the personnel system established by the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners.
