Howard County, Maryland is the Grantee organization. The Department currently manages over 9000 acres of land.					

**11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)**

Huntington Park is an 11 acre park and was first opened in 1987. It is classified as a Neighborhood Park in the County Land Preservation, Park and Recreation Plan. The Park directly serves the surrounding communities of Hideaway, Clocktower Crossing, Spring Breeze and Wood Valley but is also used for youth sports by the Department and other sports organizations.

A recently opened playground was destroyed by arson in May. The arsonist was apprehended and the County is replacing and relocating the playground including a sunshade. The requested funds will be used to design, re-construct and equipping of a basketball court, resurface and extend an existing pathway to allow a safe pedestrian connection from the
