**St. Mary's County - Local Licenses - Repeal**

This bill repeals provisions of local law regarding the licensing and regulation of hucksters and peddlers in St. Mary's County.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. The bill repeals obsolete provisions of Public Local Law in St. Mary's County.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Chapter 61 of the St. Mary's County Public Local Laws provides for the licensing and regulation of hucksters and peddlers in St. Mary's County. Provisions include (1) what hucksters and peddlers may sell; (2) license application procedures and fees; and (3) fines and other criminal penalties.

**Background:** St. Mary's County reports that there are no records of any licenses ever being issued for hucksters and peddlers under this statute.
